


RESPITE HOME

Residential Program



What It Is:

The Point Arc's Respite Program is designed to give family caregivers a break. Our respite home is ideal for caregivers seeking a safe and secure "home away from home" environment for their loved one. Our Respite Program offers a qualified, trained staff so you can put your mind at ease and take some much needed personal time for yourself.

Respite is a short-term support that is provided in the absence of, or to give relief to, any individual providing care to the person. It is available for a person who does not receive residential services and resides in his or her own home or a family home and is unable to independently administer self-care. This service is combined with Personal Assistance Services to enable a person to accomplish tasks that the person typically would do for himself or herself, if he or she did not have a disability. These include hands-on assistance; reminding, observing, guiding or training during an activity.

Where:

Located in Burlington, Kentucky, our Hammond Family Respite Home is located on a quiet cul-de-sac and available for up to three individuals with developmental and/or physical needs. A wheelchair entrance is provided at this home to allow accessibility for those in need of this accommodation.
